New Business

- Revised Winter Guard and Winter Percussion Budgets
 - Voted for the budget in June
 - Winter Guard costs have increased, and Winter Percussion has decreased
 - Budget went from \$92,400 to \$88,825
- EZ Track System for new trailer – need more and reimbursement.
 - **Motion:** Bethany moved to reimburse up to \$600 for the trailer EZ track system and parts; Brett seconded. All in favor; none opposed; motion carries.
- Marching season recap
 - Already miss it
 - May do a final performance at a third show next year so it's not a full day
 - Vanessa said a lot of students missed having three shows this year
 - Students also missed tacos in a bag
- Tent for parents for marching season
 - Approx \$499.50. Keep it in mind for next year.

- Fuel reimbursement for towing marching season
 - Grants Pass and Eugene were long drives and fuel cost has increased
 - Need to submit a reimbursement form
 - The Clark family said they were not going to request reimbursement
 - Ryan will contact the other driver
- Storage for Generator/Propane tanks
 - 3 generators and 3 propane tanks need to be stored until next marching season
 - Brett may have space
- Vanessa said an extension cord is needed for drum majors. Ryan said a few more are needed.
 - Michelle will work with Brett on the correct extension cords to purchase
 - They will go up to \$100
 - Drum majors will do inventory soon. Add to old business for later discussion.
- Have \$110 from selling bows
