Old Business

- Seeking a new Treasurer for next school year
- Jackets \$80/each for a medium weight insulation
 - Ordering 85
 - Received \$7,500 from the District that can be used for Band expenses. Submitted a request for approval.
 - Kristina suggested that we have enough for Guard. Noelle said we will start with 85 and can order more.
 - Jackets will stay with uniforms
 - Michelle asked about sizes. Noelle is working with the company for them. We'll need to measure everyone and then order bigger sizes.
- Generators
 - Order two small ones that will replace the two big ones
 - The two can connect
 - \$1,048 for two
 - Sell the other two to help pay for it
 - Michelle suggested going through Costco. Ryan explained that Amazon's generators have a higher wattage.
 - Josh suggested purchasing three instead of four
 - Amanda has powerful lights we can borrow
 - Motion – Ryan moved to purchase two generators and three plugs; Noelle seconded; all in favor; none opposed; motion carries.
- Show sweatshirts
 - Bring in any that printed poorly
 - Noelle will send them back for all to be replaced
- New trailer
 - Reviewed proposed trailer wrap
 - Will add a Les Schwab sticker on the side
 - Reviewed the large donors
 - Digital Graffiti can do a half-wrap for \$1,200
 - Have \$2,426 remaining
 - Still need a spare tire
 - Need locking hardware for the doors
 - Need to purchase straps
 - Have about \$2,200 remaining after those fees. It will pay for both trailers to be wrapped. \$200 would need to be taken out of GF.

- Kristina would like to donate funds from the tree lot from her and Brett to pay for it. She needs to get a bid to cover the old decals on the old trailer.
- Need approval to spend the money to increase security
- Motion – Michelle moved, and Noelle seconded, to use the available funds to put the wrap on the new trailer as proposed.
Discussion. Working on a program to get sponsors. Kristina needs a list of \$500 sponsors. Expand the gray shadow around the lion. Les Schwab signs will be on the side and back.
Vote - All in favor; none opposed; motion carries.
- Need to send thank you card to all the sponsors – check with Jennifer about that again.
- Sponsorship t-shirts
 - Kristina needs to know who the sponsors are by December 15
 - These are different than the trailer donators
- Still working on the insurance for trailers.
- Shannon explained why the CD moved to a Boost. The percentage increased.

New Business

- Vanessa Wallace asked about storage for percussion. Noelle responded that there will be band storage. The plan is to move back to the old Band room.
- Will still have access to the dungeon
- Discussion of building remodel
