Basketball Band, the first game is January 14th, they've been practicing and should be ready to go. All State Honor Band is January 16th – 19th in Eugene. Gracie Stearns from our Band will be there.

Travis presented his 8th grade band award photo sporting his stonewashed jeans and high-top Nikes. MS also has several members attending Honor Band. MS will have members playing in the Basket Ball band as well. Travis advised that both he and Noelle will be judging some festivals and some guest clinics. Travis will be conducting an Honor Band. The new Scale Learning program is working very well and catching on.

Our volunteers showed up on time for their shifts and made sure their shifts were covered if they couldn't make it. The lot was open from Nov 30 to Dec 22, but sold out a couple days early. Total hours worked from the Band Patrons Volunteers 304.73 hrs., equaling \$2809.12. We were the second largest volunteer group who worked the lot out of 32. They definitely want us back next year. 11 were Band members, 12 were Guard Members. The check will arrive the first week of February.
