- Can drive recommendations from Jeanelle Clark – establish canvassing zones and highlight sections for drivers to claim. Possibly purchase large identifying magnets for cars, for can drive pick-ups. Consider can and bottle parade/playing music? Maybe participate along with the food drive or on our own. Board sets can drive dates ahead of time.
