- Marching band will need prop support for shows and competitions – 6 adults per event.
- Board has agreed to pursue dry ice for “toxic waste” buckets, for show props.
- We need parent volunteers for Halloweentown parade (6:30PM October 7)– must be in costume, or “matching clothing.” Scholls have purchased, and are donating, glowing necklaces for the Halloweentown parade.
- We need to build a base for the skeleton, with appropriate tires to roll smoothly.
- December 11 and 14 concerns with SHMS are now on calender.
- December 2 is Skyview jazz festival.
- Senior night – River’s mom wants to head up this event, Friday October 20. We have 9 band seniors and 0 color guard seniors.
- Each show this season includes 10 free and 10 discounted tickets, plus 2 director passes.
